The proceeds go to the 4-H or FFA youth who in turn uses this money to pay for project expenses and to further their education.

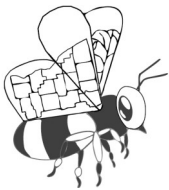
Healthy Ashtabula County

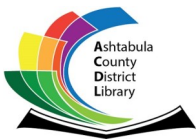


The Ohio State University Master Gardener Volunteers of Ashtabula County
